**4. Training facility and loan player payment**

It was agreed to make a payment of £500 to the club. With many upcoming home matches it was felt that a larger payment would be possible in January.

## 5. Travel Co-ordinator report

There were trips to Wealdstone and Horsham in the past month. The latter made a loss, caused by late cancellations.

Thanks were expressed to AD and Andy Field for their help in running the Horsham trip.

The possibility of running a coach to the Slough evening fixture was discussed and it was agreed that a minimum of 24 bookings would be required.

**Action point** – CB to canvas interest on the Barnet coach before making a decision to advertise Slough coach.

## 6. Tea bar report

SM explained that he would be buying stock for the next two fixtures.

Because the Torquay match in January will have segregation of away supporters, SM explained that he will have to devote all of his time to his safety officer role and wouldn't be available in the tea bar.

## 7. Match Day Draw report

MP explained that Bob Chester had arranged for Dave Mogg and Adie Mings to make the draw at the Chelmsford and Chippenham fixtures by the dug outs. It was agreed that SW will accompany the former players and act as MC.

GW suggested that it might be worthwhile to hold an Easter Draw and it was agreed to discuss this further at the January meeting.
