### 2. Sign off of Previous Meeting Minutes

It was requested and agreed that Viv White should be named as framing the team photos for sale and it was pointed out that the quiz evening raised £114 not £122.

The minutes were signed off.

### 3. Treasurer's Report

The latest accounts were shared by GW.

The SC has been compensated by £200 over the recent poor service received relating to setting up the online account (which is still not in place)

The recent renewing of the lottery licence cost £20.

### 4. Training facility

It was agreed to make a further payment of £2000 to the Club which brings the total for the season to £7000.

### 5. Travel Co-ordinator report

CB reported that there had just been the trip to Havant in the past month. She thanked AD for running things in her absence and to Andy Field and Chris Cox for organising the 50/50 draw.

There was insufficient support for a coach to run to the Gosport replay.

The Eastbourne trip will be advertised in case there are sufficient bookings and bookings are also being taken for the trips to Hampton and Chippenham.

Should the upcoming Trophy match require a replay CB will ask Berkeleys about the availability of a 16 seater to Sholing, but confirmed that no coach would run to Paulton.

The suggestion of offering online sales with a possible discount was not taken up as it would prove too expensive to set up the website to handle this.

It was agreed that when and if the relocation during the redevelopment is announced that supporters be asked to confirm if they would be interested in coach travel to home fixtures. This should help with the planning of this initiative.

## **6. Tea Bar report**

SM reported that he had spent £440 on stock, there were takings of £995 for the Concord, Gosport and Dartford matches and that he had recently paid in £615. £75 will be carried forward to the next month.

As he will not be able to staff the tea bar for the Wealdstone match he requested some assistance for CB.
